Last term the children enjoyed playing in the themed role play areas (especially the dentist and hospital) and this will continue in Term 6. 7/6/10 - 11/6/10

Post Office role play.

14/6/10 - 18/6/10

Post Office role play.

We will be looking at alternative forms of communication and how to keep safe when using them. We will also be making cards to celebrate Father's Day on Sunday.

21/6/10 - 25/6/10

We will be making holiday collages and sand print pictures.

The outing is a family event in which we will have the opportunity to look around a plant nursery and make a healthy salad with the children for us all to enjoy. The children can practice their measuring and cutting skills using wallpaper and use their gross motor skills in using the rollers.

We will be looking at and recording the weather on St Swithin's Day (Thursday of this week.) To embrace diversity we will be looking at our homes, the homes of others and houses from other areas and cultures.

19/7/10 - 23/7/10

Party and farewell week.

This week we will have party themed activities, a show and a party. The dates will follow once confirmation has been received.

Throughout the 7 weeks we will also plan activities around feelings, keeping safe around the home and outside, and we will talk to the leavers about their visits to the School and practice self-dressing skills.

To enable your child to play outside safely please could you continue to bring in water bottles, sunhats and apply the once only suncream in the morning. We will continue to provide as much shade as possible using the gazebos and will ensure your child wears a sunhat for all outside play. There will be a suncream available in Pre-School for you to apply to your child and please don't be offended if we ask whether your child is wearing any.

We would greatly appreciate any cardboard boxes that could be brought in to support the Post Office theme. You may have noticed the tree on the display board at the end of last term. This is 'our celebration tree' and your child may get the chance this term to add a leaf onto the tree for a special act of kindness, learning a new skill, exceptional listening and helping others.
